## Dear family and friends,

Thank you for your part in supporting my missions adventure. Your response has been such an encouragement to me.

For me, **faith is a roller coaster experience**: My confidence in God's leading can be strong one day, and then the next day I wonder, "What on earth am I doing?"

Missionary friends in France sent me a desktop calendar with Scripture verses on it. I keep it on my kitchen table where I look at it every day. This month's verse has been particularly reassuring: *Confie ta vie au Seigneur, aie confiance en lui et il agira. Psaume 37:5*

The literal English translation is: *Entrust (or confide) your life to the Lord, have confidence in Him and He will act.* How many people can you really confide in? Who can you trust with your fears and anxieties as well as your hopes and dreams? God is the only one who will never disappoint you.

**I am entrusting my life**—my missions experience—to **God**, and I want to share how God has acted on my behalf:

- ✓ As of the 31<sup>st</sup>, my support is at 72% and many of you have committed to pray for me.
- ✓ I needed to have a medical exam before I leave, but there were no openings until May. However, this past week, I was able to secure an appointment for April 8.
- ✓ The Lord has provided someone to housesit/rent.
